## CUT FLOWERS SECTION

1. CONTAINER OF MIXED CUT FLOWERS; one each of at least six - and no more than twelve.
2. CONTAINER OF MIXED SHRUBS; one stem of each
3. CONTAINER OF FLOWERING FRUIT; not to exceed 600mm in height
4. CONTAINER OF DAPHNE
5. SPIKE STOCK; no laterals
6. COLLECTION OF ICELAND POPPIES; no more than eight
7. COLLECTION OF PANSIES; and/or Violas, no more than six
8. CONTAINER OF VIOLETS; no foliage
9. CONTAINER OF PRIMULA; six cuts
10. CONTAINER OF WALLFLOWERS
11. CONTAINER OF CALENDULAS
12. COLLECTION OF CAMELLIAS; no more than six blooms, containers provided.
13. ONE CAMELLIA, any colour, container provided
14. COLLECTION OF BULBOUS FLOWERS; corms and rhizomes included, one only of each variety, no more than twelve
15. COLLECTION OF POLYANTHUS
16. ONE DAFFODIL
17. THREE DAFFODIL TRUMPETS
18. COLLECTION OF DAFFODILS; no more than twelve cuts
19. COLLECTION OF JONQUILS
20. BEST BLOOM OR SPIKE; of any flower not mentioned above
21. CONTAINER OF ANY OTHER FLOWERS; not mentioned above
22. PLANT OR PLANTS IN BLOOM; not to exceed 250mm in pot
23. POT FERN; not to exceed 250mm in pot
24. COLLECTION OF HELLEBORES; no more than six cuts
25. ONE CUT NATIVE IN BLOOM; not to exceed 60cm in height
26. THREE CUT NATIVES IN BLOOM; not to exceed 60cm in height
